- Dan Destout '73-Baseball. Earned three varsity letters as starting catcher. Won 1972 PA American Legion State Championship. University of Pittsburgh Baseball Captain and MVP 1977.
- Gina (McKee) Simpson '86-Soccer. Earned four varsity letters in soccer. WPIAL runner-up '82,'83,'84, WPIAL Champion '85. Three-time All-WPIAL selection. '85 Regional All-American. Four-year starter at Villanova.
- Pat Liebert '00-Football. Earned seven varsity letters (3 football, 2 basketball, 1 track, 1 baseball). PG North Fabulous 22, All-Quad North Conference, All-Valley News first team. Set FC record with 1,109 receiving yards and 12 TDS. Four-year starter at tight end for IUP. IUP rookie of the year, three-time IUP Scholar-athlete, Honorable Mention Northeast Region All-Star.
- Jim Fazzini '02-Volleyball. Earned 4 varsity letters in volleyball. Two-time All WPIAL and All PIAA. WPIAL MVP '02. USA Junior Olympic All-American. St. Francis University. NCAA Division 1 All-East selection. NCAA Division 1 Elite Eight at St Francis.
- Christa Salerno '04-Swimming. Earned 6 varsity letters (4 swimming, 2 soccer). '03 WPIAL Champion 500 Freestyle. 4-time WPIAL and PIAA qualifier in swimming. School record holder in the 200 medley relay. 4-time letter winner at the University of Toledo. US National qualifier in 200 breaststroke, 2010 US Master National Championship Silver Medalist 500 freestyle, Bronze Medalist 50 freestyle.
- Meghan Damico '05-Tennis. Earned three varsity letters in tennis. '02 & '03 section doubles champion, '02 section singles champion. '02 & '03 Valley News Dispatch Player of the Year. '04 WPIAL double 3rd place. '04 PIAA All-State. Member of '04 WPIAL and PIAA Champions. Denison University three-time All-American singles. Set school record of 20-1 in '05-'06. NCAC first-team '06 through '09. NCAC Player of the Year '07 & '08. '09 NCAA DIII Senior Player of the Year. Second in Denison History for career singles wins (60).
- David Prevost, Coach-Tennis. Girls head coach for 19 years, Boys head coach for 35 years earned 640 team and tournament wins. 25 WPIAL section titles, 40 WPIAL playoff-appearances. Two-time WPIAL team runner-up, two-time WPIAL singles champions, two-time WPIAL doubles champions.

## Winter Sports Update

### Boys' Basketball

7-7 section/11-11 overall

Senior Mike Zappala was named to the WPIAL AAAA all-section first team, junior Jake Livingston was voted to the second team and senior Brendon Urso was honorable mention. The team will lose four seniors, three of them starters, but two starters will return, as well as two players who saw starter minutes off the bench.

### Girls' Basketball

11-3 section/13-9 overall

The team advanced to the WPIAL playoffs as section runner-up, but in a heartbreaker, they lost to Canon-McMillan in the final seconds. The squad will lose four seniors —Taylor Cohen, Anna Kelly, Kayla Slovenec (who scored her 1,000th career point this season) and Sarah Supsura. Standout junior Gabby Badway, this season's leading scorer, will return as will fellow junior Bryanna Urso and sophomore Claudia Guerrieri. Post-season honors went to Gabby Badaway and Kayla Slovenec, who were selected first team all-section, while Taylor Cohen was voted to the second team. Bryanna Urso received honorable mention.

### Swimming/Diving

Boys' swimming 4-4 section/6-6-1 overall

Girls' swimming 6-2 section/9-4 overall

Overall, 13 swimmers advanced to WPIALs. Girls who advanced were seniors Kelsey Denny (200/400 free relay) and Nicola Lee-Oesterreich (200 medley relay), and juniors Sada Lantigos (100 fly, 200 medley relay), Maia Pauley (200 free, 500 free, 200/400 free relay) and Megan Wiese (200 free). Also qualifying were sophomores Joslyn Filo (200 free, 100 free, 200/400 free relay), Morgann Green (200 medley relay) and Molly Wiese (200 medley relay), and freshman Maria Luciana (50 free, 100 free, 200/400 free relay). For the boys, Alec Eckman, a senior, qualified for the WPIAL championship (200 free relay), as did freshmen Jonah Cagley (200 free relay), Colin Hackwelder (200 free, 500 free, 200 free relay) and Nathaniel Roe (200 free relay).

Three divers advanced to the WPIAL championship - junior Dixon Veltri, and freshmen Jonah Cagley and Magnus Loeffler. Jonah placed second in the WPIAL competition and advanced to the PIAA championship.

Combined, the teams will lose 10 seniors: Kelsey Denny, Nicola Lee-Oesterreich and Emily Trageser for the girls and boys' team members Che Esch, Logan Foster, Glenn Matamoros, Kristo Penner, Stephen Polcyn, Rob Rago and Ben Stevenson.

### Wrestling

3-2 section/9-4 overall

The Foxes had seven wrestlers qualify for the WPIAL championships: Seniors Derrin Dietz, Tristin Houser and Andrew Kopco; juniors Mike Mahon, Billy Meyers, Jared Pegher; and sophomore Zach Carcy. Zach and Mike both placed fourth in the tournament and advanced to the PIAA wrestling championship. Mike concluded the season in the top 16 in Pennsylvania, while Zach finished in the top 20. As a team, the squad finished second at the Buckeye Local out of 34 teams and fifth of 35 teams in the Allegheny County Championships.

### Gymnastics
