### FOX CHAPEL SPORTS

The 2015-16 year saw great success for the Foxes.

- Boys Tennis finished as WPIAL champions and a PIAA runner-ups. Freshman Robbie Shymansky finished 3rd in the WPIAL and 2nd in the PIAA while Senior Sid Rajupet finished 2nd in the WPIAL and 3rd in the PIAA
- This spring baseball, softball, boys lacrosse and girls lacrosse all earned WPIAL playoff berths after finishing as section runner-up.
- Field Hockey captured the WPIAL title.
- Boys golf finished as WPIAL runner-up.
- Boys soccer lost a heartbreaking game in overtime to finish as WPIAL runner-up as well.
- Overall varsity sports finished with an all sports winning percentage over 67% and a section winning percentage of nearly 69%.
- 23 Fox Chapel athletes will participate in NCAA athletics next season, seven of which will compete at the Division 1 level.
